

# Training Workshop on GCED in Indonesia

22 – 24 November 2017

Jakarta, Indonesia



## **Background**

In May 2015, Incheon Declaration was adopted by world leaders and this encouraged active participation in making visible changes around GCED. Following this, in September 2015, the United Nations Summit adopted the [Sustainable Development Goals \(SDGs\)](#), specifically drawing attention to the importance of ***fostering global citizenship in Target 4.7***, as a new vision of education for the next 15 years. For the past several years, promoting GCED has become a global education agenda and requires concerted efforts at all levels.

Recognizing the significant role of teachers, the Asia-Pacific Centre of Education for International Understanding (APCEIU) has been organizing various training workshops for teacher educators and trainers in order to promote Education for International Understanding (EIU) and GCED and contribute to achieving the SDG Target 4.7. In September 2017, APCEIU brought together 30 teacher educators from countries around the globe to enhance the capacity of teacher educators and trainers in implementing GCED. As a follow-up activity, APCEIU is supporting national workshops for teachers and educators to support promotion of GCED reflecting the national educational contexts. For many years, Indonesia has been actively promoting EIU and GCED and participating in diverse related programmes such as the UNESCO Associated Schools Project Network (ASPnet) and APCEIU capacity-building workshops and international teacher exchange programme. Furthermore, Indonesian National Commission for UNESCO (KNIU) is committed to continuously supporting the application of EIU and GCED in Indonesian ASPnet schools especially through whole school approach and providing capacity-building opportunities for school teachers and teacher trainers.

In this context, APCEIU and KNIU will co-organize a 3-day Training Workshop on GCED for the teachers from the ASPnet schools and trainers from the Ministry of Education and Culture of Indonesia. This training workshop aims to enhance the participants' understanding of GCED and their capabilities to implement GCED in the national and school contexts.

## **Objectives**

1. To provide the opportunities for the teachers and educators in Indonesia to improve their understanding of GCED and share best practices of GCED
2. To review current GCED practices and discuss effective pedagogies of GCED in school contexts
3. To enable participants to effectively design and develop activities to implement GCED at national and school levels
